With this in mind the *Card* is the only place where you can read weekly news on horses that feature in Marten's *Dark Horses Guides* and Jodie Standing's *Point-To-Point Recruits*.

The sections of the Weekend Card are as follows:

The Sleeper Section: Marten's highly selected – seldom more than three or four – horses to back, often very long-term projects. One example is Sehayli, who was kept on the list for well over a year before winning at 10/1 (from early 66/1) and again twice more. Others include Chatez and Rose Hip at 16/1. **This section has made a profit to level stakes of 95 points and a 57% return on investment since the relaunch.**

The Premier List Update: Marten's weekly updated comments and entries for horses that feature in the Premier List section of the *Dark Horses Jumps* and *Flat Guides*.

The Ante-Post Agenda: Marten's highly-selective ante-post nominations, sometimes invested months in advance. Numerous winners and a profit to level stakes.

Under The Radar: Horses that Marten has noted from lower-profile yards. Winners include Sugar Plum Fairy at 14/1.

The Look Ahead: Marten's information and insights for the next few days, often highlighting unexposed or unraced horses. Again a strictly limited number of selections, but includes winners at 33/1, 22/1, 11/1, 10/1 etc. **A profit to level stakes of 62 points and a 9% return on investment since the relaunch.**

The Retrospective: Marten's analysis of his previous week's selections, with entries and reference to nominations given in earlier issues.

Jodie's Jottings: Jodie Standing's fully comprehensive look ahead to the next few days, with special emphasis through the jumps season on horses from her *Point-To-Point Recruits*. Jodie has found winners at 25/1, 16/1, 12/1 etc.

Jodie has made a remarkable profit to level stakes to date of 198 points and a 21% return on investment.
